



- A) **To**  - John is **going to** the bank.
 - Lisa just **came from** work.
 - I **go from** home **to** school every day.
 - Please **drive to** New York safely!
-  **From**



- B) **On**  - The cat **jumped on** the table.
 - **Get on** the bus. / **Get off** the bus.
 - Don't **put** your bag **on** the table.
 - Be careful not to **fall off** the slide!
-  **Off**



- C) **Into**  - Jane is **walking into** the office.
 - Tom **walked out of** the doctor's office and **into** the pharmacy.
 - I **took** the shoes **out of** the shoebox.
-  **Out of**

- D) **Up**  - We **climbed up** the hill.
 - **Walk down** the stairs to the basement.
 - He **walks up and down** a mountain every morning.
 - We **hiked down** into the valley and **back up** again.
-  **Down**

- E) **Along**  - We **walked along** a beautiful river today.
 - I **drive through** a tunnel every day to work.
 - The river **runs through** the city.
 - I saw a man **running along** the path today.
-  **Through**

- F) **Across**  - We **walked across** the street.
 - There's Mark. He's **walking towards** us.
 - We **saw** some deer **across** the field.
 - That car is **driving straight towards** us!
-  **Towards**

- G) **Over**  - The bird **flew over** the house.
 - We **walked under** the bridge.
 - The baseball **flew over** the fence. Homerun!
 - The dog **hid under** the sofa. He's so shy.
-  **Under**

- H) **Around**  - We **drove around** town looking for our dog.
 - I **walked around** the corner to the café.
 - We **walked past** the soccer stadium.
 - My friend **walked right past** me!
